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Report of Counseling Facility

The Counseling facility at K.B. Joshi Institute of Information & Technology started from 01st April 2022. The Counseling facility is made available for students, parents, and staff of college. The appointed Counseling Psychologist - Ms. Anagha Kulkarni is available in the college every Friday from 2.00 pm to 4.00 pm in Placement cell.

Initially the work started with conducting an Orientation session for the staff about the counseling facility at the unit. The following points were included in the session:

- Brief introduction about counseling facility & the need of it in the college.
- The type of concerns that would be addressed under counseling was brief starting from academic issues, personal issues or discomforts, family issues, concerns at multiple levels would be addressed under counseling service was made known.
- The Referral system was discussed with Professors & how they could make the referrals was finalized.
- The professors can observe and refer students for counseling. In any case about academic or personal concerns. The pointers for observations were discussed.
- In case of need, the parental involvement would be added. Parental counseling sessions would be provided as per the requirement.

The counseling facility work started with conducting Orientation lectures for students of MSC & MCA course. To make the students acquainted with the counseling facility an email system was developed wherein the students from first year to last year all were emailed about the counseling facility & the details to communicate with the Psychologist.





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The session about the Introduction of Counseling Facility was delivered to the students of First Year of BCA & BSC.IT. The strength was around 150 plus students in the Induction program. Likewise a similar session was delivered to the students of Third Year of BCA & Bsc.IT.Accordingly the students by themselves approached the Counselor through email & call. In total there are 07 ongoing cases.

Counseling doesn't always imply understanding of a problem situation & arriving at a solution. But it also has the approach of enhancement & enrichment of individuals who undergo it. While rendering counseling service to the unit it was focused that each & every person from the unit that comprises teaching staff, Non-teaching staff etc. should be benefitted from the service. Therefore separate Group sessions for staff were arranged.
